As of April 3, 2010, all agencies which qualify pipe welders operating in New York City are required to be approved in accordance with 1 RCNY 101-07 (http://www.nyc.gov/html/dob/downloads/rules/1_RCNY_101-07_040310.pdf). In accordance with section (C)(8)(v) of this rule, pipe welder qualifying agencies are required to renew their registration every 3 years. Based on our records, your registration will expire on March 22, 2019.

If you intend to continue performing as an approved agency to qualify pipe welders, please review this letter, and return a signed and dated original copy no later than February 22, 2019 in order to allow for sufficient processing time and avoid a suspension of approved status with the Department.

All approved agencies shall employ testing administrators that comply with either of the following (please submit proof of certification):

1. An AWS Certified Welding Inspector or Senior Certified Welding Inspector, or
2. A quality control manager of a manufacturer or contractor holding an ASME Certificate of Authorization.

The test administrator shall perform the following duties:

1. Verify welder performance qualifications are in accordance with ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code Section IX or API 1104-1977 (only applicable for gas pipe welding with the 1968 NYC Building Code).
2. Positively identify each welder or welding operator who is being qualified.
3. Observe the welder or welding operator during the qualification test.
4. Verify all welder qualification records (e.g., QW-484 forms as published by ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code Section IX or equivalent) accurately record the data required by ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code Section IX or API 1104-1977 (only applicable



- with the 1968 NYC Building Code).
5. Sign the welder qualification record and submit a copy to the department when required.
 6. The qualifying agency shall not engage in any activities that may conflict with their objective judgment and integrity, including but not limited to having financial or other interest in the qualification of the welder. A quality control manager or their designee shall be considered sufficiently independent to satisfy this requirement when a manufacturer or contractor has an ASME Certificate of Authorization.

If your registration as an approved agency expires, your company will be required to cease qualifying pipe welders in New York City. Contact OTCR if you have any questions or require additional information.

Your signature below indicates your agreement to satisfy the requirements as outlined in this letter, including but not limited to qualifications and duties of approved agencies for qualifying pipe welders, and compliance with 1 RCNY 101-07. Agency qualifications and signed agreement shall be mailed to The Department of Buildings, 280 Broadway, 7th Floor, New York, NY, 10007, Attn: The Office of Technical Certification and Research. If approved, your company will continue to be listed as an approved agency for qualifying pipe welders.
